Mike provides therapeutic counselling interventions directly with young people in schools and delivers training on ADHD, mental health and other neurodevelopmental conditions to schools, organisations and parents across the UK as well as adult coaching, specialising in working with neurodiverse clients. He also provides administrative support to the All Part Parliamentary Group for ADHD. Prior to joining the ADHD Foundation, he had a long teaching career in the secondary sector, majority of which was at Middle leadership level.

Clare is a teacher, PhD student and big sister to an autistic young man. She is author of 'The Teacher's Guide to Pathological Demand Avoidance: Essential Strategies for the Classroom' published by Jessica Kingsley Publishers in 2021. She has been director of an alternative education provision for students with PDA and now provides education packages for PDA children and young people who cannot access school.
